

ARTHRITIS & AGING RESEARCH GRANT

All submitted projects must clearly demonstrate the role of aging as it relates to arthritis and be an integral aspect of the proposed study.

Purpose: In a collaborative effort, the Arthritis National Research Foundation (ANRF) and the American Federation for Aging Research (AFAR) are seeking grant applications that focus on studying the underlying mechanisms of the aging process as it relates to arthritis.

Applicants: Applicants must be newer M.D. and/or Ph.D. applicants at early stages in their faculty careers. (equivalent to assistant professor level or instructor).

Budget and Project Period: Applicants may request up to \$100,000 in direct costs only. The project period is one year, with the option to apply for a second year if significant progress is demonstrated. The grant period is July 1, 2020 – June 31, 2021. In 2020, priority is given to applicants with no prior funding from ANRF.

Application: The research grant application is supported by proposalCENTRAL. All policies and guidelines can be found by visiting CureArthritis.org/grants

Submission Deadline: Applications must be submitted online by Friday, January 17, 2020.

Review Process: Submitted applications will be evaluated by an expert panel of peer reviewers and the award will be announced by May 15, 2020.
